
## Safety Complaints to NRC from employees & other external sources

Non-Operating U.S. Nuclear Power Reactors January 2009 to June 2015 (6.5 years)



**Nuclear Regulatory Commission** (NRC) refers to complaints as "allegations from external sources" (all sources external to the NRC). Majority of complaints are from employees & other on-site sources. These are reports of impropriety or inadequacy of NRC-related safety or regulatory concerns. Includes non-operating U.S. operating nuclear power plants & reactors with one or more allegations. One allegation report may contain multiple allegations. However, the NRC counts it as one allegation in these statistics. A complaint about a safety-conscious work environment problem is important, but a Notice of Violation cannot be issued, because there is no applicable NRC regulation. \*San Onofre complaints dropped after major staff reductions.
