Fuel at the San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station

Christopher Macon City Manager Dear President Picker:

On Wednesday, January 21, 2015, the Laguna Woods City Council approved a resolution calling for certain actions to be taken and issues considered with respect to the storage of spent nuclear fuel at the San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station (SONGS). We consider the storage of spent nuclear fuel to pose a threat that could potentially result in harm and imperilment to public safety both in Laguna Woods and, more generally, in the broader Orange County area. As you may be aware, our community is located approximately 20 miles from SONGS.

On behalf of the City of Laguna Woods, I urge your office to join immediately in the efforts set forth in the attached resolution with the goal of protecting public health and safety.
